Our church went through a challenging year in late 2022 and early 2023 and are now poised to move forward and we are seeking a pastor who can guide us to accomplish our vision and mission given to us for God's glory.

We are excited about our future and are looking forward to this "new chapter" for our church, our faith journey, and our ministry of spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Where We Are:

Charity Lutheran is located in the growing community of Bismarck, N.D. Bismarck is North Dakota's capital city and is part of the larger Bismarck-Mandan retail trade area, with a population of approximately 103,000. Bismarck is filled with culture, history and outdoor activities, including hunting, fishing and exploring nature. Bismarck overlooks the Missouri River, a popular natural resource with beaches and sandbars used extensively for recreation and conservation, and is not far from Theodore Roosevelt National Park. - Hold a Masters of Divinity degree.
- Be certified with LCMC, or be willing to become certified within a specific period of time.
