- 7. Coordinate all aspects of worship.
- 8. Provide counseling, corrective action, healing and growth.
- 9. To speak publicly to the world in solidarity with the poor and oppressed, calling for justice and proclaiming God's love for the world.

- 10. To seek out and encourage qualified persons to prepare for the ministry of the Gospel.
- 11. To strive to extend the Kingdom of God in the community, in the nation, and abroad.
